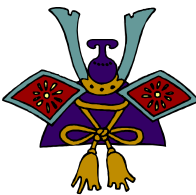

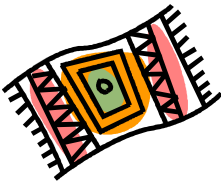
Climate Change and the Casco Bay

Traditionally used to protect and decorate floors, the thick canvas rugs are attractive as well as sturdy enough to hold up to lots of wear and tear. There is a \$30 materials fee for canvas, paint, hemming, and varnish. *All materials are water-based and safe for kids to use.*
